Participants in Sojourns Abroad are expected to adhere to the General Terms & Conditions specified on page 2 of the Application which each has signed and submitted. By enrolling in Sojourns Abroad, participants also agree to fulfill the following expectations:

Specifically sojourners will attend language classes and complete assignments in order to progress in learning to speak Italian or French. Because tardiness affects everyone in the class, those who arrive more than 15 minutes late may not be permitted to enter class that day and may need to schedule (and pay for) a private language lesson in order to keep up with the class.

Sojourners are expected to attend the weekly group check-ins. In addition, we strongly encourage sojourners to take advantage of the cultural seminars and midweek excursions, and to participate in the varied supplementary activities (art, music, culinary classes, cultural seminars, etc.) and weekend trips.

Sojourners agree to act as responsible adults by:

- Drinking alcohol only in moderation
- Being recreational drug-free for the duration of the session
- Foregoing activities deemed by the Directors as "too risky"
- Treating others with consideration and respect

Participants who may occasionally travel independently are expected to make plans as far in advance as possible, and to inform the Resident Director of the destination, means of transportation, and date and time of return. Because Sojourns Abroad weekend excursion require advance planning, this is particularly important regarding independent weekend travel. Of course, independent travel means that sojourners undertake the planning as well as the execution of such trips on their own.
